CincyAfterSchool grows to 28 Cincinnati Public School sites with 14 grant awards via the federal 21st Century Community Learning Center grant administered by the Ohio Department of Education starting July 1st! This five year investment of \$11.9 million comes at a critical moment in the development of our community's commitment to extended learning opportunities, as we all have just celebrated the close of Fifth Quarter which gained significant national attention!

New sites include Douglass, Roberts, Rothenberg, Saylor Park, Taft, and Woodward. The original 8 community learning center sites include Hays, Oylar, Pleasant Ridge, Riverview East, Rockdale, South Avondale, Taylor, and Winton Hills. Currently in year two or three of the five year grant period, the following sites continue to serve 75 to 125 students per site: Academy of World Languages, Carson, Chase, Hoffman, Hughes, John P. Parker, Mt. Airy, Pleasant Hill, Rees E. Price, Roll Hill, Shroder, Silverton, Westwood, and Winton Montessori.

Special thanks to Cincinnati Public Schools, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Cincinnati, the Urban League of Greater Cincinnati, and the YMCA of Greater Cincinnati for submitting applications. Central Clinic and Families Forward also participated in key planning activities to continue the original programs.

In order to quickly connect lead agencies to the new sites, the district plans to release a request for proposals in early July with selections by each school's LSDMC in early August. The CincyAfterSchool Summer Institute, held August 17th – 28th at Mayerson Academy, offers youth development training for start-up and continuing program partners.
